Stitching	Pass	Fail
Loose or missing stitches		
Discolored stitches		
Stitches that are cut or torn		
Hard or shiny areas (caused by heat damage)		
Other	Pass	Fail
Harness tag is attached and legible		
Harness is still within the manufacturer's adopted service life policy		
Harness is clean (free of excessive stains, odor, etc.)		
Other fall protection / arrest hardware (inertial reel, shock lanyard, etc.) is in good condition and operates as appropriate
