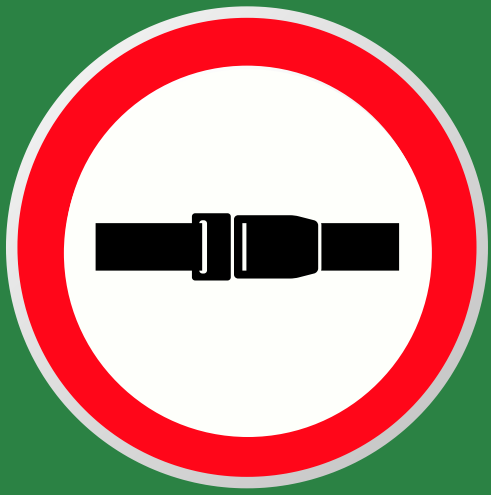


PIT EQUIPMENT SAFETY



Buckle Up.

Use the seat belt. It will keep you secured in the unplanned event of a tip over.



Follow parking protocol.

When parking, ensure your forks are flat on the floor, with controls set to neutral, and the parking brake engaged if applicable.



Travel at a safe speed.

PIT operation is not a race. Always ensure you are driving at a safe enough speed to stop quickly, react to changes in the work area, and avoid obstacles.



Stop at the right time.

Stop at all blind corners and intersections to check for traffic, including PITs and pedestrians. Honk before proceeding.



Complete inspections.

Equipment must be inspected before each shift. Any issues must be identified and reported to a supervisor. Never operate a damaged PIT.
